

RADICAL CREATIVITIES COPYRIGHT AGREEMENT

- a. The Author hereby represents and warrants that he/she is the sole creator and copyright holder of all rights on the Contribution and that such does not in any way infringe or violate any intellectual property or related rights (including any copyright, database right, moral right or trademark right) or any other right or interest of any third party. In addition, the Author hereby represents and warrants that in case any other work protected by copyright is used in the process of creation of the Contribution or in case the Contribution is a collective or composite work in which other creators and/or copyright holders have contributed, the Author shall be solely and exclusively responsible for obtaining any and all licenses for the use of such work from the copyright holders or from the creators and right holders of the individual contributions for the use of such in the creation of the Text and shall include proper citation of such in the Text. In case KEA suffers any loss or damage (financial or of any other kind) due to the fact that the Author did not comply with any of his/her aforementioned obligations, the Author shall be liable to fully compensate KEA for such loss. The aforementioned compensation due to KEA shall also include all expenses incurred by the latter for its legal representation against claims of third parties on that basis as well as any other remuneration and loss of revenue.
- b. By virtue of the present agreement the Author hereby transfers to KEA the following copyrights on the Contribution:
 - i. The right of fixation and the right of direct or indirect, temporary or permanent reproduction of the Contribution (in part or in its entirety) in any way or form, on any immaterial or material carrier of audio and/or video, for any kind of use, either commercial or non-commercial use, promotional or advertising, in the frame of activities related to the promotion of the Editorial Project but also for the general promotion of the goals and activities of KEA.
 - ii. the exclusive of translation of the Contribution into any other language or editing/adapting/adjusting of the Contribution, by associates selected by KEA at its sole and absolute discretion, subject to respect of Author's moral right at all times.
 - iii. the right of distribution to the public of the material carriers integrating the Contribution in every form, through sale, rental, (public or private) lending or in any other way, for any legal use, commercial, marketing and promotional of the Editorial Project or for any and all of the endeavors or activities of KEA;
 - iv. the right of presentation/communication of the Contribution to the public through wired or wireless means or in any other way, as well as the right of making the Contribution available to the public, so that anyone may have access it where and when they choose (on demand), indicatively for downloading from the website of KEA, for distribution on digital platforms on the Internet, for exploitation through any kind of new digital technology and means as well as the Internet etc., irrespective of the technical means (computer, mobile device or other) and of the conditions of receipt/access of the public to it (free of charge, or through subscription, on demand, pay per view or other).
- c. For any and all such uses or ways of exploitation KEA shall not owe any compensation to the Author for any reason whatsoever.
- d. KEA remains obliged to obtain approval and consent of the Author beforehand.
- e. While exercising any or all of the aforementioned rights, KEA shall at all times respect the Author's moral right on the Contribution, ensuring proper accreditation of him/her in an appropriate manner.
- f. KEA is in no way obliged to exercise the aforementioned powers, the exercise of which constitutes a right and not an obligation of KEA, hence lies at its absolute discretion. In view of the above, the Author hereby waives his/her right to request the making available or publication of the Contribution in any way. However, in case KEA does exercise any or all of the aforementioned powers, such exercise shall be done by respecting and protecting the Author's right of paternity on the Contribution, by assuring proper accreditation of her/him at all times.
